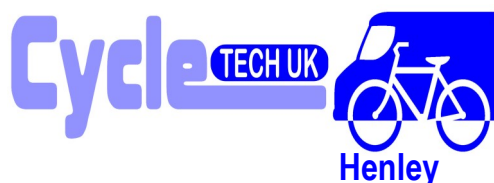
The challenge will take them through to United Learning's Bournemouth
